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Background

- Regional Utilities Group (RUG) was convened periodically by Dept of Public Service (Ed McNamara) to obtain input, exchange information and inform "Team VT" advocacy on key regional (ISO-NE) issues
- Ed recently named Planning Director
- DPS has asked VELCO to take over role of convening RUG
- VELCO had informal conversations with multiple participants (utilities, DPS) to assess what was working, what could be improved



Proposed statement of RUG purpose

- Gather multiple perspectives on key regional issues
- 2. Identify areas of alignment and divergence
- 3. Where appropriate and feasible, coordinate regional advocacy roles and responsibilities

Proposed approach

- Hold face-to-face meetings quarterly
- Coordinate timing with VELCO Operating Committee
 - Op Com meets, generally in Montpelier, on the 3rd
 Thursdays of each month, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
 - RUG would meet in Montpelier at the VELCO office (Blanchard Court) from 9 to 10:30 a.m. allowing time for Op Com participants to get across town
- Hold conference calls between regular meetings as needed
- Regular topics: Markets, Participants
 Committee, DER integration, what else?
